All in Ministries (AIM) International works with churches and missionaries worldwide to train and equip under-resourced individuals to be disciples who make disciples of Jesus Christ. Serving ministry partners across Asia, Africa, Europe, and North America, AIM works with local leaders and missionaries to offer intensive women's disciple-making workshops, online training, and mentoring. AIM's vision is to see the ministry multiply by equipping others to train women worldwide.



ANTECESSOR RAPID RESPONSE

In 2003 Antecessor Rapid Response was formed to provide an effective vehicle through which the church planting organizations can network and rapidly respond to disasters when they occur in unreached areas of the world. Their mission is to plant churches among the neediest and least reached peoples of the world. Their goal is to train and equip missionaries from Central America to serve in various regions of the the globe. Currently, Antecessor serves the Middle East and the Balkans. Our partnership will assist in covering the cost of training for new candidates that Antecessor will be sending into the mission field.



CITY OF **REFUGE**

Colombia has the largest population in the world of internally displaced persons. The country's 50+ year civil war and ongoing clashes between the military, leftist guerrilla groups, and rightwing paramilitary groups leave hundreds of thousands annually fleeing their homes and migrating to urban centers in search of shelter and economic opportunity. Few find work or have the courage to register themselves to receive government support, and others fall victim to gang and drug activity on the city streets. City of Refuge provides a refuge for those in need through the provision of humanitarian aid and holistic programming. Through feeding, housing, recovery, education, and work-readiness programming, they help provide both short-term and long-term assistance for those interested in restoring their lives and creating lasting change for their futures.



ESMIRNA SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF

Esmirna School for the Deaf is the only school for deaf children in the entire country of Honduras. Located in San Pedro Sula, Esmirna was founded by people in a local church who want to bring the hope of Jesus alongside a quality education for students with hearing disabilities.



FORTRESS INTERNATIONAL

Fortress International exists to expand God's Kingdom through multiplying authentic Christian communities (house churches) and individuals throughout East Asia, Thailand, and other parts of the world. 250,000 people have been directly impacted by Fortress Trainers. FPSM IN HAITI

Foundation Pierre Smith Mondelus (FPSM) is a Christ-centered ministry established in 2016 as a cooperative effort between Haitian and American leaders. Their goal is to equip and empower residents of rural villages in northern Haiti for neighborhood revitalization through sustainable personal, community, and economic development.

LIVING **HOPE**

In 2000, Living Hope was founded by a local church in Cape Town, South Africa to respond to the HIV AIDS crisis with the love and the message of Jesus Christ . Their vision is to reach people for Christ, bring hope, and break the despair of poverty and disease prevalent in the townships of South Africa. Currently, Living Hope serves in 8 townships in South Africa. Living Hope aims to spread the good news of Jesus Christ and encourage people to follow Him, undertake community development through education social and health-related programs, and play a vital role in care, prevention, and support of people affected by HIV, AIDS, and other chronic illnesses. Our partnership with Living Hope will assist in paying the salaries for Life Skill Educators in the Mzamomhle township.



MARK & JANA FAUS

Mark and Jana Faus serve as USA-based missionaries with the SIM mission agency after serving overseas for decades in other ministry roles in several countries.

Mark and Jana have served full-time on the SIM International Health Ministries Team in roles that support SIM's global medical network of 320 medical missionaries serving in 28 hospitals in 25 countries. In April 2022, Mark moved from the Health Ministries Team to begin serving as the International Governance Consultant for SIM. Jana now serves as the Special Assistant in Governance, working alongside Mark in the global coordination of this governance ministry. In this role, Mark oversees the Director Boards of all 70 ministry countries where SIM operates worldwide.
